FROM 1-95 (NORTH OR SOUTH):

Exit 15 Route 7, follow expressway to the end, approximately 3 miles. At traffic light, turn right, pass through one light, down to second light, turn right onto Main Avenue. Turn right at second light which is the entrance ramp to Building 201 & 301.

FROM MERRITT PARKWAY (NORTH OR SOUTH):

Exit 40B, at end of ramp turn right on to Main Avenue. Pass the Merritt Shell Gas Station on the left. At the fourth light, turn left to the entrance ramp to Building 201 & 301.

FROM DANBURY AREA:

Follow signs to Route 7 South. Travel through Ridgefield, Wilton into Norwalk. Pass intersection for Route 7 Connector (Motor Vehicle Department is on left). Continue straight to second traffic light. Turn right into entrance to Building 201 & 301.

ALTERNATE ROUTE FROM RIDGEFIELD AREA:

Follow signs for Route 33 through Ridgefield into Wilton. Route 33 connects with Route 7 in Wilton. Follow directions above.

BY TRAIN FROM NEW YORK CITY:

Take the New Haven line toward Danbury and get off at the Merritt 7 station; it is on the Danbury line of the New Haven Train. Take a taxi to 201 Merritt 7 Corporate Park, which you can see from the train platform. It is the complex of four tall brick and glass office buildings on the same side of the train tracks, but on the other side of the fence. It is very close by but you can not walk to the building because there is no walkway over the train tracks or through the fence.
